

**TAPI "HOT SHOT SPECIAL ACHIEVEMENT AWARD" RECEIVED BY

Celeste Tetzner RN, Immunizations Coordinator at Canyonlands Community Health Care, won the "Hot Shot--Special Achievement" Award given by TAPI, The Arizona Partnership for Immunization.
